### 28 February 2022

Upon commencement, the new planning scheme will replace the Torres Shire IPA Planning Scheme (July 2007). The new planning scheme applies to the entire local government area of Torres Shire. The new planning scheme will be Torres Shire Council's local categorising instrument under the *Planning Act 2016* and will be used by Council to categorise development and assess development applications.
