This year's budget totals \$42.9 million which include operating expenses of \$23.5 million and capital expenditure of \$19.4 million.

Council actively pursues state and federal government funding opportunities to assist in funding projects for our communities. This year, capital grants and subsidies included in the budget is to \$15.0 million.

Total amount of \$19.4 million capital projects is included in the budget of which Council will fund \$4.3 million. Some of the key projects that Council plans to deliver in 2024/25 are as follows:

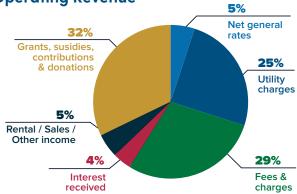

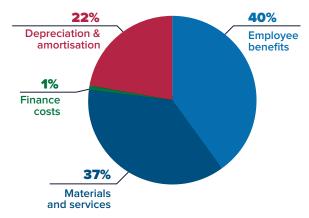
Council's operating revenue and expenses for 2024/25 is outlined in the below graphs.
